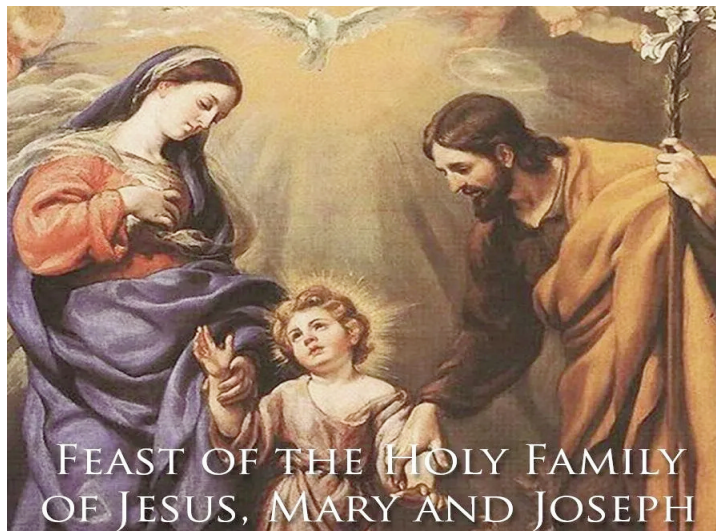

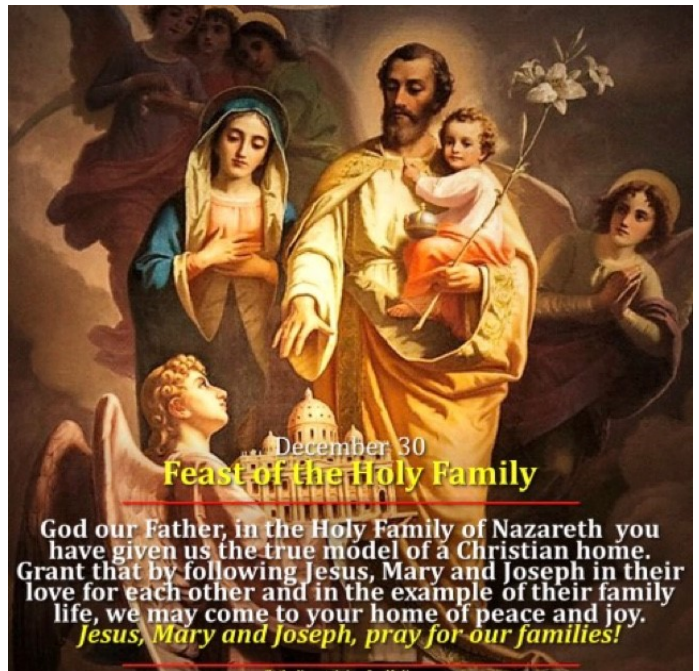

Continuing from last's week message.

I want to share with you these statistics that the diocese shared recently. They are not new, and we all have seen these before. Please pray for them and pray with our youth and invite them to open their hearts to the possibilities of vocations.

1- We have 254 active diocesan priests. Of that, 209 are currently assigned to parishes.

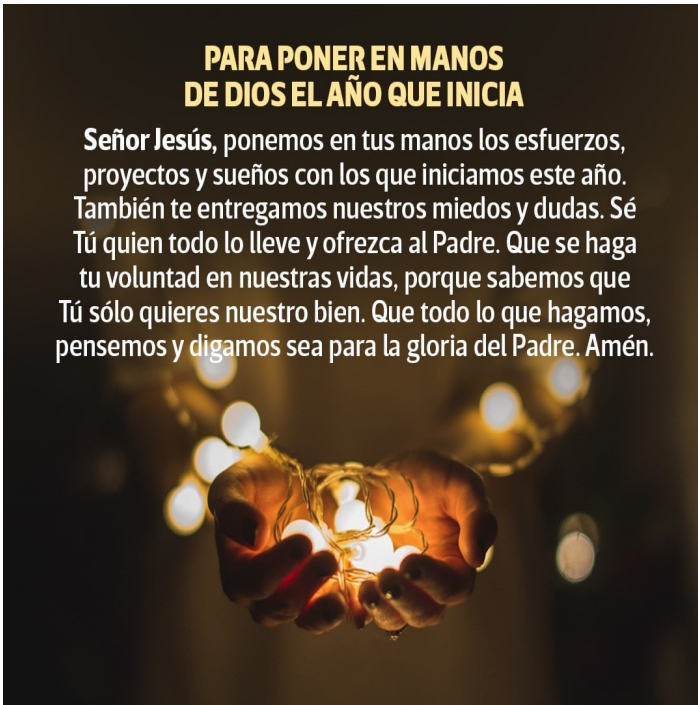
2- We have 146 retired priests some of which are healthy enough to help in parishes, but many are no longer able to assist in that way.

We are a diocese of less than two hundred parishes, some of which are partnered and in the process of merging, like ourselves. That means most parishes have only one priest assigned to the parish and the Pastor tries to get sacrament assistance when necessary from some of the retired priests who are healthy enough to help or from student priests -non diocesan - like our resident priests, whose primary responsibility is to go to school and thus in many cases are limited in their ability to fully assist. It takes a minimum of 5 to 6 years to complete the major seminary formation system and that is after college and after a few years of discernment with the vocations director and his team helping the young man discern his call.

We need to storm heaven with prayers, invite young people, especially those from our parish, to discern a vocation to the priesthood, and challenge families, especially those good families in our parish who come from Latin America, and Haiti, to talk to their children and invite their children with their blessings to go into the seminary.

MENSAJE IMPORTANTE DEL PADRE GANNON.

Sobre la nota de la semana anterior...

Quiero compartir con ustedes estas estadísticas que la diócesis compartió recientemente. No son nuevas, y todos las hemos visto antes. Por favor oren por nuestros jóvenes e invítenlos a abrir sus corazones a las posibilidades de las vocaciones.

1. Tenemos 254 sacerdotes diocesanos activos. De ellos, 209 están actualmente asignados a parroquias.
2. Tenemos 146 sacerdotes jubilados, algunos de los cuales gozan de buena salud para ayudar en las parroquias, pero muchos ya no pueden hacerlo.

Somos una diócesis de menos de doscientas parroquias, algunas de ellas asociadas y en proceso de fusión, como nosotros. Eso significa que la mayoría de las parroquias tienen un solo sacerdote asignado a la parroquia y el párroco trata de obtener asistencia sacramental cuando es necesario de algunos de los sacerdotes jubilados que están lo suficientemente sanos para ayudar o de sacerdotes estudiantes -no diocesanos- como nuestros sacerdotes residentes, cuya responsabilidad principal es ir a la escuela y por lo tanto en muchos casos están limitados en su capacidad para ayudar plenamente.

Se necesita un mínimo de 5 a 6 años para completar el sistema de formación del seminario mayor y eso es después de la universidad y tras unos años de discernimiento con el director de vocaciones y su equipo, que ayudan al joven a discernir su llamada. Necesitamos llenar el cielo con nuestras oraciones e invitar a los jóvenes, especialmente a los de nuestra parroquia, a discernir una vocación al sacerdocio, y desafiar a las familias, especialmente a esas buenas familias de nuestra parroquia que vienen de América Latina, y Haití, a que hablen con sus hijos y los motiven a considerar ir al seminario.

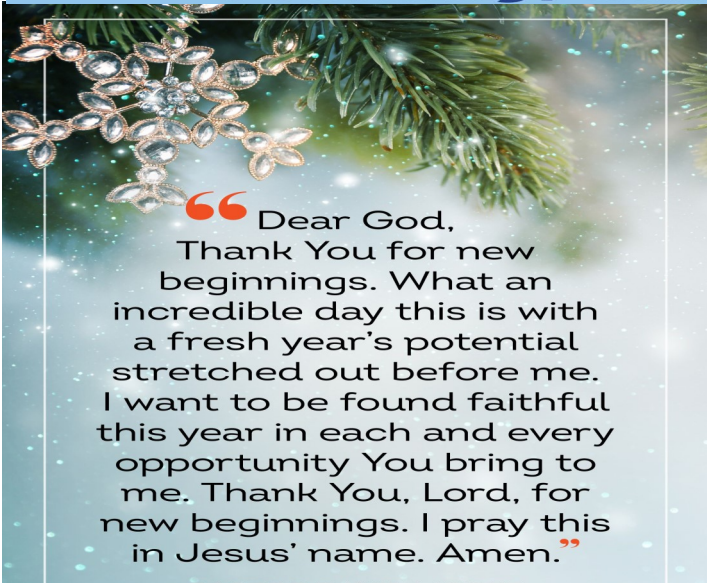

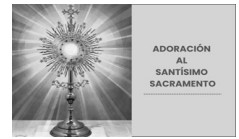


